As a follow up to last week's discussion before the Board of Supervisors, this letter is written to confirm that there will be no golfing or construction activity at the Trinitas Property. The PG&E project to bring in power on the north side , designed to alleviate the use of the AG generator , has been suspended indefinitely. the final installation of the entry gate for our families entry on the south side of the existing gate has been put on hold.

Please understand that we clearly understand the message from the last board meeting and we respect the need for a clear political climate during the time of our project's review. The only activities that will be occurring on site will be the mowing of the golf course and the activities associated with the annual olive harvesting in late October and early November. We hope our formal reiteration of our commitment to this approach will help assure that the processing of our project application can proceed without conflict or confusion. Again, please accept my sincere promise that there will be no golfing or construction at Trinitas.
